

California-grown Persimmons *variant*

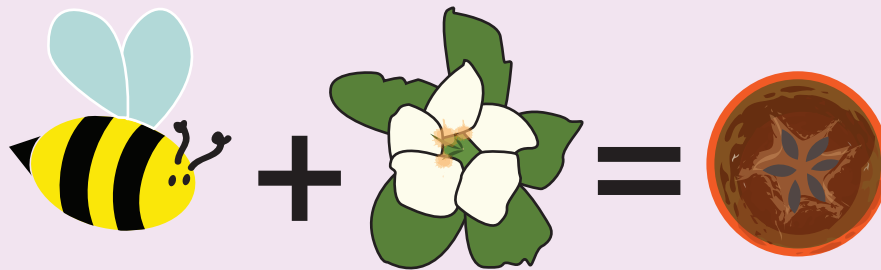
What is a variant persimmon?

The technical name is “pollination-variant, non-astringent type persimmon”

They are a unique kind of persimmons

Variant persimmons require pollination to

turn the inside pulp brown • reduce astringency • develop rich flavors



complete, partial, or no pollination may occur

How to enjoy variant persimmons

The inside of the fruit looks like...



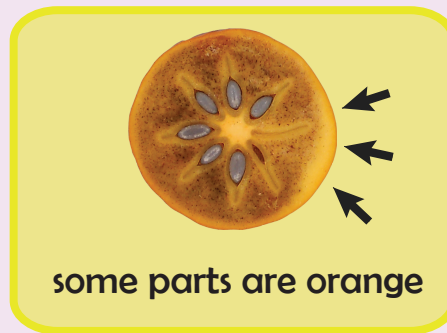
completely brown -or-
speckled brown throughout

(complete pollination)



enjoy
as is!

some parts are orange

(partial pollination)



the fruit
is still good,
but astringent!

carefully cut into slices &
freeze for 24 hours
before eating



no brown

(no pollination)
