Set up New Cultures with Egg Layers

Set up Egg Layers/New Cultures 1:

Materials:

- Fumehood
- LGB cultures with adults
- # 14 and # 30 sieve & pan setup
- Pour pan
- Aspirator
- Graduated cylinder, Nalgene®, 10 ml

Procedure – performed under fumehood:

- 1. Shake culture and pour ca. half into sieve
- 2. Shake sieve to separate beetles from diet
- 3. Return material from both #14 sieve and bottom pan to culture jar
- 4. Aspirate adults from #30 sieve
- 5. Transfer 1 ml adults into each new culture jar using graduated cylinder and funnel
- 6. Close jar with wire mesh and filter paper lids
- 7. Place new jars in holding room for development
- 8. Discard old colony jars by removing labels and placing in freezer

Clean up:

Wipe down and disinfect surfaces of fumehood and cart before handling another species Place all materials used in handling insect in freezer before proceeding
