2009 FRRL Service Support Award

Dr. H. Paul Rasmussen is being awarded the FRRL Service Support Award based on his significant contributions in support of FRRL's mission and increased stature. Dr. Rasmussen, as Director of the Utah Agricultural Experiment Station, has provided long-term research support to FRRL through direct and indirect activities. Much of the scientific knowledge developed and academic success achieved at FRRL during more than 20 years would not have been possible without the commitment of the Agricultural Experiment Station through funds, land resources, and human services. He led the effort to establish Utah State University and FRRL as a center for irrigated pasture research that is recognized nationally. This effort resulted in the development of the Lewiston Grazing Facility. These actions have increased and will continue to increase the national and international recognition of FRRL.
